

## **CHANDLER NAMED HBAA REMODELER OF THE YEAR**

**Montgomery**—Kenneth Chandler of Huntsville has been named the Home Builders Association of Alabama (HBAA)'s Remodeler of the Year for 2017.

Chandler was honored during the HBAA's Annual Convention awards presentation on October 27, 2017 at the Henderson Beach Resort in Destin, Florida. The Remodeler of the Year award recognizes a remodeler member who has shown outstanding service to their local and state associations, their community and the remodeling industry as a whole.
